Community Emergency Plan for
Gissing

Gissing Parish Council is establishing an Emergency Plan to aid response in the event of an emergency affecting the community of Gissing.

The loss of water, electricity and the possibility of flooding are example risks for this area, whether due to severe weather or a man-made disaster, this could coincide with the Emergency Services being tied up with big incidents in surrounding towns & cities. The best way for the village to respond and recover is through good old fashioned community spirit: local people helping their neighbours and other local people.

South Norfolk Council is helping each Parish Council to create a community based Emergency Plan. Gissing Parish Council has agreed to be Volunteer Emergency Co-ordinator for the Parish.

In an emergency, we will need to know who will help (say with specialist knowledge, skills and equipment, or, as a volunteer) and who might need help (because of, for example, illness, infirmity, mobility). So, our first task is to contact all the households in the Parish and ask for help. If you can answer **yes** to any of the following questions, **please complete the form on the reverse**:

- Do you have equipment that you could make available, in an emergency, to help people in this Parish?
- Do you have special personal skills (e.g. medical training) or specialist knowledge?
- Are you able to offer general assistance (e.g. visiting an elderly or infirm person), in an emergency, to help people in this Parish?
- Alternatively, would you require specific assistance in an emergency (e.g. to access medication, help in the home)

If called upon to use your equipment by the Emergency Planning Team of SNC in an emergency, you will be covered by SNC's insurance although you will not be reimbursed any expenses.

Any information that you supply will be **confidential** and be treated in accordance with the Data Protection Act– it will be kept secure and will only be shared and used in an emergency by representatives of Gissing Parish Council, the Emergency Planning Department of SNC and Norfolk Constabulary. Your details will not be given to any other 3rd parties and not used for any other purpose than stated above.
